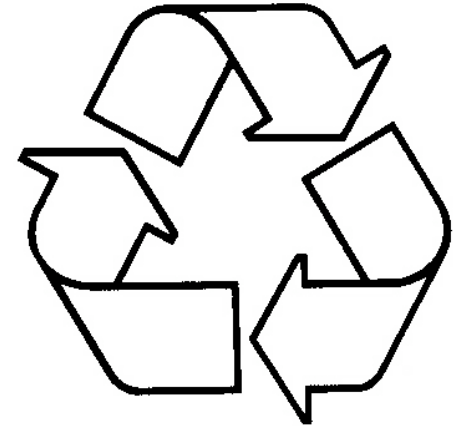

Bulky Items • carpets • mattresses • TVs • computer monitors • large appliances • broken furniture

Scrap Metal all metal (except for tin and aluminum cans)

Demolition • brick • concrete • sheetrock • rock • sand • dirt • painted wood • window glass • clean gypsum wallboard

Mercury • compact fluorescent bulbs (CFLs) • fluorescent tubing • thermometers • thermostats • button batteries • rechargeable batteries • car batteries

Note: It is illegal to throw mercury in the trash

Pharmaceuticals call the Health Department 508 349 0308

HAZARDOUS or TOXIC MATERIALS REQUIRE SPECIAL DISPOSAL

• Solvents, motor oil, gasoline, explosives, sewage. Chemicals, household cleaning fluids, combustible or noncombustible fluids of any type or composition. Hospital/ biological waste, animal/human waste, nuclear/radioactive material, pesticides, and fungicides

Metal & Plastic

Food and Drink Containers

- Tin, steel, aluminum cans & lids
- Plastic containers labeled 1-5, and 7 check bottom of container for a symbol like this:



also 2,3,4, 5 & 7

No plastic bags, unnumbered plastic or polystyrene

Returnable Cans and Bottles

- Please sort in the returnables area

Glass

- Bottles and jars only

No broken glass, window glass, mirrors, light bulbs, or ceramics

Yard Waste

- Grass and leaves • Christmas trees
- Branches 6' long x 2" in diameter maximum

No vines, tree stumps, or large timbers
